I hereby apply for a float at Gorslas Carnival and confirm that I have read, understood and accept the terms outlined below.

1. Each articulated lorry float must have a minimum of 8 adults, who must take responsibility for any children on the float with no more than 25 persons on the float in total.
2. Each rigid lorry float must have a minimum of 3 adults, who must take responsibility for any children on the float, with no more than 10 persons on the float in total.
3. Whilst the floats are in motion, every person must be seated and away from the edges of the trailers.
4. Children must be kept towards the centre of the float.
5. Strictly no alcohol on the floats prior to or during the parade.
6. Each float organiser and participants have been made aware that should there be any injuries to persons on board the lorry driver, lorry owner and the committee of the Gorslas Welfare Association will not be held responsible for any claims that may arise.
7. Each float must supply stewards to walk alongside during the parade.
8. Lorries to ensure flashing beacons / hazard lights are used when parade is in motion.
9. The individual float organisers have been made aware that there is no insurance cover for any incidents arising whilst the float is on the parade. They are responsible to notify all participants prior to the commencing of the parade.
10. The lorry driver, lorry owner and the carnival committee will not be held responsible
11. The individual float organisers have been made aware that the safety of all participants is their responsibility and should they require individual insurance then that is also their responsibility.
12. Lorries will be allocated to individual floats by the Parade Marshalls (Gavin Griffiths and/or Gareth Jones). Each float organiser must provide (from the lorry owner) a copy of the insurance, driving licence of the intended driver and copy of their Operators Licence (if applicable).
13. No lorries will be allowed to join the Carnival procession unless the appropriate paperwork (as 12 above) has been supplied and approved by the Parade Marshalls.

14. Individual floats organisers will be advised as to the times for preparation, set up and departure of the Carnival procession on the day.

15. A £25 entry fee for each float is payable to Gorslas Welfare Association with the application form.

16. Prize money: Best Float £100, 2nd £50, 3rd £25.

17. **No application forms will be accepted after WEDNESDAY, 15 MAY.**

By signing in the declaration below, as float applicant I confirm that I have read, understood and accept the conditions as set out overleaf and above. I accept that the lorry driver, the lorry owner and the committee of the Gorslas Welfare Association will not be held responsible for any claims that may arise though non-compliance with the terms and conditions as outlined and that all participants on the float are aware of this.
